From our May drive with HCC to Le May's collection

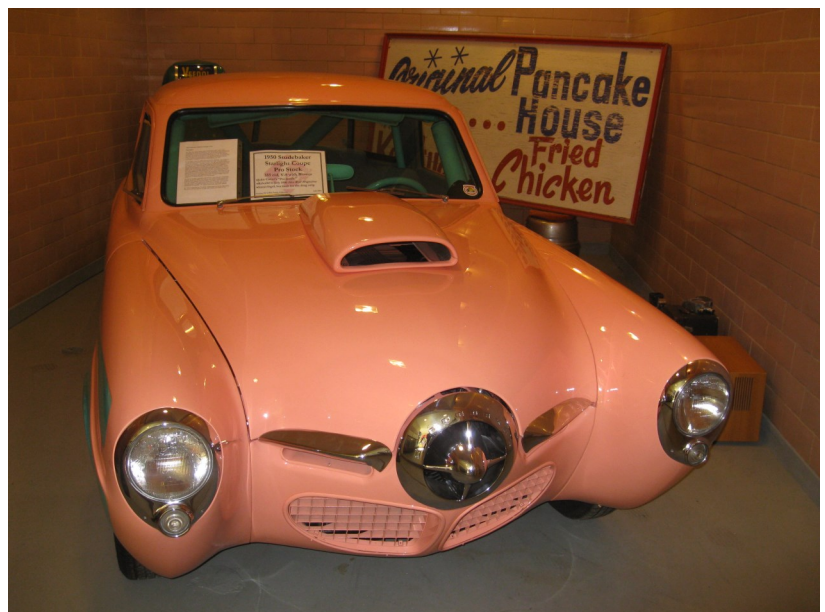
Greetings,

Follow Smith up the hill and continue through the intersection at 104th. At that point, Smith turns into SE Kent-Kangley Rd, also known as SR-516. Continue on SE Kent-Kangley Rd but name changes to 272nd Street

At 152nd Avenue SE, take a right. 152nd turns into Kent-Black Diamond Rd SE

Take a right onto 165th Avenue SE.

Club member,

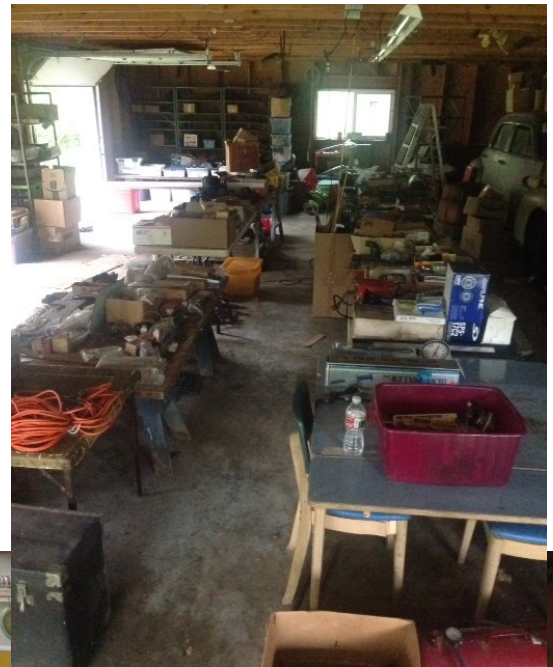

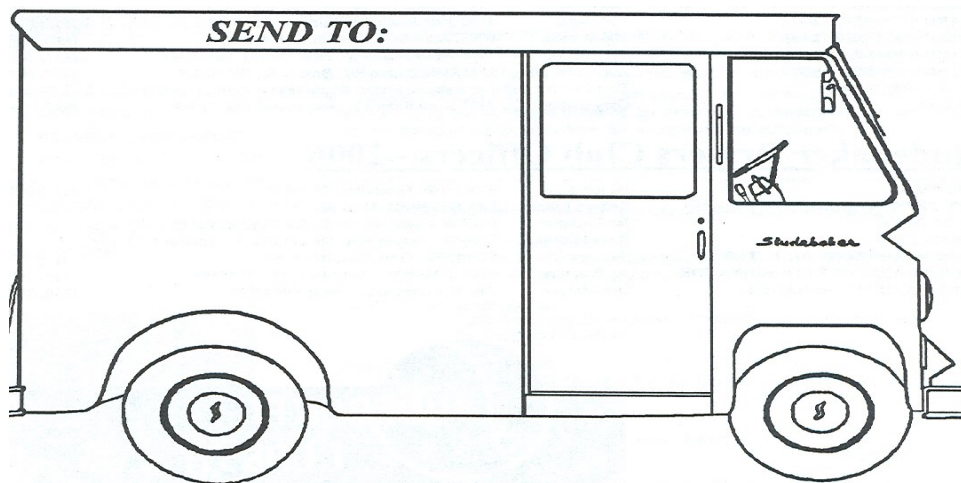

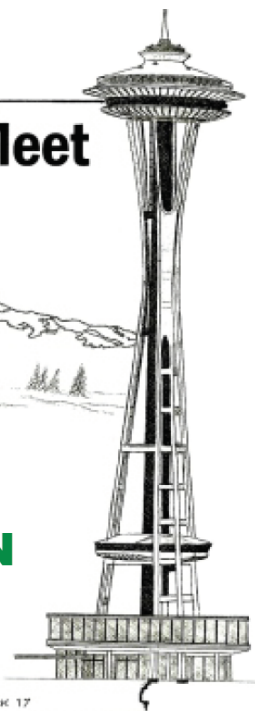
